Train details:



After following the western shore of Wellington Harbour and the Western Hills, the line heads east across the Hutt River. It then passes through the residential lower valley past the Institute of Technology at Heretaunga, Trentham Army Camp and Trentham Racecourse, finally terminating at Upper Hutt. But, there is a lot to do on the way.

At Petone cross the overbridge and follow the signposts for the brief walk to Percy's Scenic Reserve. This is a comfortable native bush walk with ducks to feed along the way, so don't forget the stale bread. Or, alternatively, take the bridge over to the town side of Petone and browse through the shopping area; the lovely foreshore, long jetty and beach walk are only a block away. And there's always the Ten Pin Bowling which is just a short walk from the station - ask at the Information Office at Petone Station.

To get to the ever-growing Queensgate Shopping Centre, you leave the train at Waterloo station and walk, (ten minutes) or take one of the many buses running to the City Centre. If you do go into the Hutt City Centre, you must visit the Dowse Art Museum with its great contemporary arts and crafts shows, which you can discuss at its fantastic cafe - go easy on the cake.

Or, stay on the train as far as Upper Hutt and spend time at the Upper Hutt Leisure Centre just 3 -5 minutes walk from the station with no roads to cross. The Centre has two indoor pools and users have access to the Wave Machine, River Ride, Waves Cafe, Waterslide and other very modern facilities. Highly recommended. On race days take the train to Trentham Racecourse, the station is at the course's front door and we have a special Fast Track fare which includes entry to the racecourse.

Trains run on the Hutt Valley line seven days a week. Services run half hourly, and depart more frequently during the weekday morning and evening peaks.

Fares are designed to suit all travel options. Two options are the Day Rover* (\$10.00) or the Group Ticket** (\$20.00) which allow all day train travel. But, best of all you can get on and off the trains to visit different places and even travel on other lines during the same day. These tickets can be purchased on the train.

*The Day Rover is available from the commencement of off peak services (as shown in the Tranz Metro timetable), all day Saturday, Sunday and on public holidays.

** The Group Rover is available from the commencement of off peak services (as shown in the Tranz Metro timetable), all day Saturday, Sunday and on public holidays. A "Group" is up to four people travelling together.
